1. From the Ashes

Burro Ave. was rebuilt in 1911 after a fire, one building is still standing.

2. Burro Avenue in 1932

Where the railroad crossed, on the way to the Mescalero Apache Reservation.

3. Burro Avenue 1903

Cloudcroft's commercial district as it appeared from 1899-1909.

4. Texas Hotel-Built in 1899

Tourists arrived by stage from the railhead.

5. Old Lodge

Completed in 1901, it was the crown jewel of the railway's construction projects.

6. Excursion Train

Tourists arriving in 1930 at the Cloudcroft Depot, in excursion cars converted from old boxcars.
